A love offering given at the close of each cantata enabled the establishment of the Currituck Community Chorus Music Scholarship Fund, administered by Sharon United Methosit Church.



The Currituck Community Chorus Music Scholarship in the amount of \$1000 will be administered by Sharon United Methodist Church with a Board that will determine the awarding of the scholarship as described below:

An academic scholarship is open to anyone who graduates from Currituck County Schools (public, private, or home schooled) and who meets the criteria established in Part 1, Qualifications below, including an audition, and who submits a completed application postmarked on or before May 15, 2020 and mailed or delivered to Sharon United Methodist Church.

Part I: Qualifications

- Have maintained a minimum overall "C" average in the secondary school General Course of Study, but a minimum "B" average in music related courses.
- Be pursuing a Music Degree in the areas of Instrumental or Vocal music,
 Music Education, or Performance from a university, college, community
 college, post secondary school, or North Carolina School of the Arts.
- Be accepted by the institution and into the program you plan to attend.
- Enclose an official transcript.
- Complete an essay to be written in cursive with blue or black ink in which you specifically define your career goals and explain how this scholarship will be important for you to turn your goals into reality (See Part III for specific directions.)
- Submit three letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a band, chorus, or music teacher (either public or private) who has instructed you in your area of expertise. (See Part IV for specific directions)
- Prepare and present a three to five minutes audition of your area of expertise to members of the Board for the scholarship. Time, date, and place will be set by the Board. A piano will be available; however, you must supply a pianist or CD player if you will use taped music for vocal auditions and other instruments and equipment you will need for your audition.

Part II: Application (for 2020 Currituck Community Chorus Music Scholarship)

The one thousand dollar (\$1000) Currituck Community Chorus Music Scholarship will be paid directly to the institution that the recipient is attending and may be used for tuition, books, laboratory fees, or other fees directly required for the music program in which the recipient is enrolled. It is expected that by the end of the first year this \$1000 scholarship will be used for education expenses. While the scholarship is granted for only one year, recipients may apply for an additional year by submitting a new application. A scholarship not used during the first year and having no written request for a second year extension will be terminated and the funds returned to the Currituck Community Chorus Music Scholarship account.
